The college has a well equipped state-of-the-art fully computerized and air-conditioned library that caters to the academic and intellectual needs of both students and faculty. It offers free internet access, an open-shelf system, and photocopying facilities to ensure that students are provided with essential tools for academic success. The library holds a collection of 34,565 books, covering both the prescribed curriculum and areas of general interest. It subscribes to a wide range of national periodicals, journals, magazines, newspapers, e-journals, and databases. To ensure safety and efficient operation, the library is monitored by eight CCTV cameras. The Library includes separate sections for undergraduate and postgraduate students. Additionally, a dedicated reading area allows students to bring and use their personal books. In addition to the Central Library, the college also maintains departmental libraries that support subject-specific and practical learning needs. Furthermore, in alignment with the college's commitment to inclusive education, the library supports students from economically weaker sections through the "Earn While You Learn" scheme. This initiative not only provides financial assistance but also engages students in meaningful academic support roles within the library.
