Leave Rules and Absence Fine

- 1 Student shall apply for leave whenever needed on the prescribed form obtainable from the college office. Leave application also has to be counter signed by the parents of the student.
- 2. Student must submit her application herself before availing leave and not after absenting herself from the college except in sickness case in which the application must be submitted on the date when the student attends the college after recovery along with medical certificate.
- 3. Leave upto 3 days can be granted by the tutor or any teacher teaching her class and upto 7 days by the Faculty head/Senior most teacher and more than 7 days by the Vice-Principal on the recommendation of the tutor / Head of the faculty.
- 4. Under University Rules if a student remains absent from the classes for 15 days or 50% of classes in a month or for 6 days continuously without leave or medical, her name shall be struck off from the college rolls irrespective of the fact that she had paid her dues. Only once the defaulter can be re-admitted as per university norms with the readmission fee of Rs. 500/-.
- 5. Absence without leave will be fined Rs. 5/- for each period, absence in monthly mentor's tutorial will be fined Rs. 50/- per tutorial, absent in class test will be fined Rs. 100/- per paper.
- 6. Leave does not mean cordonation of attendance. Student has to complete 75% attendance excluding leaves.



The students appearning as private candidates and opting for a subject having Practical Examination may be admitted in college on casual basis in the month of September.

COLLEGE LEAVING RULES

Students leaving the college must get their names struck off from the college rolls by submitting an application, otherwise due fees will be charged from them. They must also collect their original documents from the College immediately after they leave college but not later than six months.

REFUND OF SECURITIES

The college securities will be refunded to the students within one year of the last session attended after showing clearance from library, office, hostel (in case of hostellers) canteen and NCC (if NCC Cadet) etc. The securities not withdrawn between 15th to 30th March will lapse to the college.

CONDITIONS FOR APPEARING IN UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION Class Tests / Sessionals and submission of assignments will be strictly held according to KUK rules.

Conditions for Appearing in Semester Examination

Only such students will be permitted to appear in the University Examination who fulfill the conditions specified under Special Regulations as follows :-

- a) **Class Test :-** A student shall not be eligible to appear in the University Examination unless she appears & pass the class tests.
- b) **Two assignments :** Students are required to submit two assignments per subject in each semester in addition to Class Tests.
- c) **75% Attendance :** A student shall not be eligible to appear in the University Examination unless she has attended at least 75% of the full course of lectures delivered to her class in each of the subjects.
- d) Students absenting themselves from the Class Tests/Sessionals without leave shall be fined at the rate of Rs.100/- per paper as it is compulsory for all the students to take the Class Tests and students not submitting the assignments in time will also be fined.

STUDENTS SUPPORT & FACILITIES

Grant of Fee Concessions, Books, Scholarships and Stipends

Fee concessions, books and scholarships are granted to poor, brilliant students, good sportspersons and holders of distinctions in co-curricular activities. Government, University, UGC, Private (By trusts & Individual) and all other scholarships like State and National Merit scholarships, scholarships for SC/BC and scholarships for the wards of serving employees of college are also available in the college.

All concessions & scholarships are subject to good behaviour, satisfactory academic results and regularity in attendance. These scholarships/concessions may be withdrawn at any time —

- (a) If it is found that the recipient has ceased to deserve it on account of some lapses on her part.
- (b) If the student does not appear or fails in class Test, sessionals or end semester exams.
- (c) Only one benefit of scholarship & concession will be awarded to a student at one time.

Students Aid Fund

The college provides financial aid to the poor and needy students in continuing their higher studies. This fund is administered by a committee and Principal. **Needy students are to apply alongwith the affidavit of family income.**

LIBRARY - FACILITIES AND RULES

1. Library books are issued to every student on Library Identity Card on computer. The number of books which a student can borrow will be as under :

I) PG Program : Four

ii) UG Program : Two

- 2. Meritorious & economically weak students are allowed to get as many books issued from the Library **Book Bank** on the recommendation of teachers.
- 3. Any loss of books should be immediately reported to the Librarian and the matter may be settled within 10 days by either replacing the books or by paying postal expenses alongwith double cost of the book.
- 4. Books will be issued for a period of 10 days (Books may be reissued for more seven days if not in demand). Delay will entail a fine of Rs. 3/- per book per day.
- 5. Students on leave must arrange for the return of books in time.
- 6. Books issued from the library must be kept very carefully and in no case be underlined or disfigured. If the book is already damaged in any form, it should be brought to the notice of the Librarian before getting the book issued, otherwise, the person who returns the book will be held responsible for the damage.
- 7 Reference books, rare books and periodicals shall not be issued except for consultation in the Library premises.
- 8. General books from the reference sections will be issued for overnight use only. The rate of overdue charges for such books will be Rs. 5/- per day.
- 9. The original holder of the Book shall be held responsible for the return of book.
- 10. Students must be wearing their Identity Cards with them whenever they enter the College Library. They can be refused admission to the library or can be turned out of the library if they are not wearing the I-Card around their neck.
- 11. If an Identity Card is lost by any student, the duplicate will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/-.
- 12. Students are expected to read the Notices issued from time to time by the Principal/Librarian. No excuse will be entertained for ignorance.
- 13. The students are expected to observe perfect silence in the Library and not to disturb others in any way.
- 14. Facility of photostat & print out of reading material from the books is available in the library.
- 15. Internet facility at 24 x 7 hours is also available in library.
- 16. E-resources through N-list can be accessed anywhere/anytime with login & password.
- 17. Student must sign at entry register on every visit to library.

Career Guidance and Information Bureau

A career guidance cell has established in the college to guides the young aspirents (UG & PG) towards various career openings. For this, college library subscribes 'Vocational Guide', a Fortnight Bulletin issued by **Kurukshetra University Career Information and Service Bureau** which gives information on career and other related areas to the students. It helps the students in choosing right career so that they can settle down in life and enjoy true happiness.

The main features of the bureau are :

- * To provide information & guidance on educational and vocational matters.
- * To prepare guidance literature to help students in connection with giving them training and directions for competitive examinations.
- * To motivate unemployed educated youth to adopt self employment as an alternative to the paid employment.
- * Students are advised to take advantage of these facilities available at the Bureau which is open on all working days.

Career Guidance & Placement Cell

The college has a Career Guidance & Placement cell for the students to enable them to meet the challenges of the global market. It makes all-out efforts for the proper placements of the students through interviews by various reputed companies every year.

CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

Cultural Activities

Everyone has a hidden artist within oneself. To unleash one's artistic potential and to showcase one's talent, the college provides a perfect plateform by organising **Talent Show, Intra College contests** in Debate, Declamation, Poetic, Music, Fine Art and Home Science activities. The college has various Associations / Societies to develop students' talent. They organise various activities like Dance, Gidha, Music items, Creative Writing, Collage making, Painting, Mahendi, Rangoli, Quiz, Slogan Writing etc. The students participate in **Youth Festival** organised by K.U.K. Our college is being adjudged the Best Women College and overall Runner up Positions continuously for the last so many years.

Sports Activities

To bring about general physical fitness in the students and to develop a sense of sportsmanship special emphasis is laid on creating a healthy balance between class room and the play field. Facilities exist for various sports and games. The sports dept. of the college organises Athletic Meet. The college has a Gym also. The players participating in the university tournaments must attend atleast 50% to 60% of lectures in each subject during their stay in the college. Football, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Yoga, Athletics, Cross Country, Badminton & Judo etc. are the games in college in which the student are able to participate.

National Service Scheme

The college started N.S.S. in 1976. Now there are two units of NSS working in the college. The aim of this scheme is to develop all round personality of the students, to make them responsible and patriotic citizens and to develop in them the sense of dignity of manual labour. N.S.S. provides forum to the young

students for social service in their spare time. Under the scheme two types of programmes are organised. Regular activities and camping programme. A large number of students take part in these activities and our college is one of those colleges who have got top positions in University and National level due to their excellent performance. Those students who want to be the member of this scheme will have to fulfil the form at the time of admission obtainable from the college office

Red Cross Society

The purpose of red cross society is to develop a zeal in students to help the poor and needy. The college helps the poor students by providing text books, fees, shoes, socks & sweaters in winter out of the red cross society fund. It also organises Blood Donation Camp, Haemoglobin and Dental Check up Camps etc. in collaboration with NSS unit and other activities according to the University / Govt. instructions.

Shakti Manch - The Women Development Cell

Women cell has been established in the college as 'Shakti Manch' under Women National Policy of Education. The college has healthy tradition of holding regular mentorship tutorials for all round personality development of students and for better interaction between the teacher and taught. Every teacher acts as mentor is entrusted with the assignment of interacting with a group of 30 students.

Healthcare of Students

The college actively organizes various initiatives to ensure the well-being of its students. The college regularly arranges visits from doctors and medical professionals who provide essential health consultations and screenings. Additionally, College organizes health camps and health talks, where students receive valuable information on maintaining physical and mental health, preventive care and healthy lifestyle choices. These efforts not only address immediate health concerns but also educate students on long-term wellness practices. By fostering a supportive and health-conscious campus environment, AKMV College demonstrates its commitment to the holistic development and overall well-being of its students.

VOTER CARD

Students are required to get their Voter Cards made soon after turning 18 yrs. of age. A photocopy of Voter Card should be attached with the admission form.

AADHAR CARD

Students are required to get their 'Aadhar Cards' made. They will be needed for depositing scholarships etc. Attach photocopy.

Prizes & Awards

Prizes and Awards are awarded at the Annual Prize Distribution Function for top positions and distinctions won in University Examinations and remarkable achievements in Sports, Athletics, N.S.S., N.C.C. and Youth Welfare Activities to encourage the students. Special prizes & certificates of Excellence are granted to the All round best student and student who prove themselves best in Academics, Dance, Acting, Singing, Speech, Poem Recitation, Sanskrit Declamation / Shlokacharan, Fine Arts Activities, Home Sc. Activities, Best Library user and Hosteller etc.

Code of Conduct for Students

- All the students should get their Identity Cards from College Library after their admission. It Should be signed by the Principal. Students must wear their Identity Cards during their stay in the college. It is the duty of a student to show her Identity Card if demanded by the Principal or any other lecturer/authority of the college. It should not be passed on to other students. In case of loss/damage/theft, a New Identity Card will be reissued to a student only on a payment of Rs. 100/- with the special permission of the Principal.
- 2. Students must read the notice board before leaving the college to get information about instructions/orders issued by the Principal from time to time.
- 3. Student must remain in discipline and it is their moral duty to show respect towards their teachers and elders.
- 4. Students are advised not to roam around in the varandahs or outside the classrooms under any circumstances so as to avoid disturbance in teaching class. Use of mobile in classes without teacher's permission is strictly prohibited. A fine of Rs. 500/- will be imposed on violation of this rule.
- 5. If any student is found violating any of the code of conduct or any other instructions displayed on notice board from time to time, the Principal will have the right to suspend/terminate the student from the college.
- 6. The girls should come to the college in dignified and proper dress.
- 7. Smoking and use of drugs in the college campus is a punishable offence.
- 8. Student are expected to protect college property and maintain the beauty of the campus by their appropriate actions.
- 9. Students are also advised not to sit on staircases to avoid inconvenience to others.
- 10. Not student should take part in any strike or provoke any other student to go on strike or any illegal activity whatsoever. Violation of this rule may attract stringent punishment.
- 11. If the teacher is on leave the students should to quietly to library and study books, newspapers/ periodicals.

- 12. Calling out any student from the class is undesirable and will be considered as an act of gross indiscipline. Parents must contact the office to call their wards from the class after explaining the emergency, involved. In such a case the student will be called by the office and allowed to meet the parents/guardians.
- 13. Students are not allowed to bring/invite outsiders in the college premises.
- 14. It is mandatory for all the students to be present in the college functions, failing in which will lead to the imposition of fine on them.

Student Grievance Redressal Cell (SGRC)

Students Grievance Redressal Mechanism :

- The student can put up her grievances in writing and drop it in complaint box or through college e-mail (akmshahabad@yahoo.com)
- The Grievance Cell acts upon those cases which have been forwarded along with the necessary documents.
- The Grievance Cell ensures that the grievance is redressed within fifteen days.
- Zero tolerance policy is there for guilty.
- There will be strict action against the false/unauthentic complaint.

Anti-Ragging

Arya Kanya Mahavidyalya, Shahabad Markanda is a No Ragging & No Smoking zone.

Objective

AKMV is dedicated to providing a safe and respectful environment for all students. Ragging, in any form, whether verbal, written, or physical, that results in teasing, mistreatment, or psychological harm to any student, is strictly prohibited and will be met with severe consequences. This policy outlines the behaviors considered as ragging, the consequences for those found guilty, and the commitment of college authorities to eliminate ragging.

What constitutes Ragging

Ragging includes one or more of any of the following actions:

- Any behavior by students, whether spoken, written or physical, that teases, mistreats, or handles a fresher or any student rudely.
- Rowdy or undisciplined activities by students that cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm, or fear in any fresher or student.
- Asking a student to do something they normally wouldn't, causing them shame, torment, or embarrassment, affecting their physical or mental well-being.
- Actions by senior students that prevent, disrupt, or disturb the academic activities of any student or fresher.

- Using a fresher or any student to complete academic tasks assigned to another student or group of students.
- Financial extortion or forcing a fresher or any student to bear unnecessary expenses.
- Physical abuse, including sexual abuse, assaults, stripping, obscene acts or gestures, causing bodily harm or endangering health.
- Verbal or written abuse, public insults, deriving sadistic pleasure, or participating in the discomfort of a fresher or any student.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any student, whether intended to derive sadistic pleasure or show power or superiority.

Consequences

Anyone found indulging in ragging will face severe consequences, which may include:

- Expulsion from the college.
- Suspension from the college.
- Imposition of fines.
- Public apology.
- Collective punishment in cases where individuals responsible cannot be identified.

AKMV Commitment to Eliminate Ragging

The college is committed to eliminating ragging in all its forms. This includes:

- Adhering strictly to the regulations and laws in force as per the direction of UGC and Kurukshetra University in accordance with Anti-Ragging Regulation 2009.
- Fostering a safe and respectful environment for all students.
- Ensuring that all students are aware of the anti-ragging policy and the consequences of engaging in ragging.

Reporting Mechanism

Students are encouraged to report any instances of ragging to the college authorities. The college will ensure:

- Confidentiality of the complainant.
- Prompt and thorough investigation of all complaints.
- Appropriate action against those found guilty.

Policy for Disabled Persons

To create a disabled friendly, and barrier free environment, Arya Kanya Mahavidyalya, Shahabad Markanda is determined to provide/create :

- 1. A disable friendly environment with ramps for easy access to classrooms.
- 2. Disabled friendly washrooms.
- 3. A provision for enquiry an information in terms of human assistance, reader or a scribe as and when required.

छात्राओं तथा उनके अभिभावकों के ध्यानार्थ प्रमुख नियम

1. <u>न्यूनतम उपस्थिति</u>

- ★ प्रत्येक विद्यार्थी के लिए प्रत्येक विषय की कुल उपस्थितियों में से 75 प्रतिशत उपस्थितियां अनिवार्य हैं अन्यथा वह विश्वविद्यालय की वार्षिक परीक्षा के लिए अयोग्य समझा जाएगा। अत: उसे विश्वविद्यालय का रोल नं∘ जारी नहीं किया जाएगा।
- ★ किसी एक या एक से अधिक विषयों में छ: दिन लगातार या एक महीने में 15 दिन अनुपस्थित होने पर छात्रा का नाम महाविद्यालय से काट दिया जाएगा। प्राचार्या की अनुमति मिलने पर तथा 500/- रू. पुन: प्रवेश शुल्क जमा करवाने पर ही पुन: प्रवेश प्राप्त हो सकता है। पुन: प्रवेश केवल एक बार हो सकता है।

2. <u>अवकाश</u>

- ★ छात्रा निर्धारित फार्म पर ही छुट्टी का प्रार्थना पत्र दे सकती है। यह फार्म महाविद्यालय–कार्यालय से नकद भुगतान कर प्राप्त किया जा सकता है। अस्वस्थता (Medical) के अतिरिक्त अन्य सभी दशाओं में अवकाश आवेदन पत्र पहले जमा कराया जाना आवश्यक है। माता–पिता/ अभिभावक के हस्ताक्षर करवाना आवश्यक है। तीन दिन तक के अवकाश के प्रार्थना पत्र पर टयूटर अथवा कक्षा के किसी भी प्राध्यापिका के, 4 से 7 दिन तक के अवकाश के लिए विभागाध्यक्ष अथवा वरिष्ठ प्राध्यापिका के तथा सात से अधिक दिनों के अवकाश हेतु उप–प्राचार्या के हस्ताक्षर अनिवार्य है। अस्वस्थता–अवकाश (Sick Leave) के लिए डॉक्टर के प्रमाणपत्र सहित छुट्टी का प्रार्थना पत्र महाविद्यालय में लौटने पर तुरन्त जमा करा दिया जाना चाहिए।
- ★ ध्यान रखें कि अवकाश लेने पर अनुपस्थिति का जुर्माना नहीं लिया जाएगा, किन्तु इस अवकाश काल को उपस्थितियों की गणना में शामिल नहीं किया जाएगा। अतएव अवकाश के आधार पर न्यूनतम उपस्थिति तथा आंतरिक-मूल्यांकन (Internal Assessment) के अंकों में उपस्थिति का हितलाभ प्राप्त नहीं किया जा सकता। बिना प्रार्थना पत्र दिए अनुपस्थित रहने पर 5/- रूपये प्रति कक्षा जुर्माना होगा।

3. विश्वविद्यालय परीक्षा के लिए अनिवार्य योग्यता एवं आंतरिक कक्षा परीक्षाएं

- ★ प्रत्येक विद्यार्थी द्वारा आंतरिक–कक्षा परीक्षा देना और उसमें उत्तीर्ण होना अनिवार्य है, उक्त के अतिरिक्त दो हस्तलिखित Assignments प्रत्येक सैमेस्टर में प्रत्येक विषय में जमा करानी होगी। अन्यथा उसे विश्वविद्यालय की परीक्षा हेतू अयोग्य समझा जाएगा एवं रोल नं. जारी नहीं किया जाएगा।
- ★ महाविद्यालय में विषम सत्र (पहला, तृतीय, पांचवा) की आंतरिक परीक्षा सितम्बर/अक्तूबर में तथा सम सत्र (द्वितीय, चतुर्थ, षष्ठ) की आंतरिक परीक्षा मार्च/अप्रैल में ली जाएगी।

4. <u>आंतरिक मूल्याकंन</u>

प्रत्येक विषय (theory only) में आंतरिक मूल्याकंन (Internal Assessment) के अंक Class Test, Quiz, Seminar, Class Interaction etc. के आधार पर दिए जाएंगे।

5. <u>प्रार्थना सभा :-</u>

प्रत्येक सोमवार को पहले तीन कक्षाओं (पीरियड) के बाद प्रार्थना सभा आयोजित की जाएगी। जिसमें सभी छात्राओं का श्रद्धापूर्वक भाग लेना अनिवार्य होगा।

6. <u>पहचान पत्र (Identity Card)</u>

प्रतिदिन अपने साथ पहचान-पत्र लाना अनिवार्य है। पहचान पत्र के बिना महाविद्यालय प्रांगण तथा कक्षा में प्रवेश की अनुमति नहीं होगी। पहचान पत्र गुम हो जाने पर 100/– रूपये की राशि महाविद्यालय पुस्तकालय में जमा करवाने पर पहचान–पत्र की दोहरी प्रति बनवाई जा सकती है।

7. <u>फीस भुगतान</u>

विद्यार्थी को फीस तथा अन्य निर्धारित शुल्क निश्चित समय पर जमा करवाने होंगे अन्यथा बकाया राशि विलम्ब शुल्क सहित वसूली जाएगी। निर्धारित शुल्क पूर्ण रूप से जमा न करवाने पर विश्वविद्यालय परीक्षा हेतू रोल नं. जारी नहीं किया जाएगा।

8. <u>पुस्तकालय सेवा का उपयोग :-</u>

- ★ विद्यार्थी पुस्तकालय-कार्ड पर 07 दिन हेतु पुस्तकें निर्गमित (issue) करा सकते हैं। इस अवधि के बाद प्रत्येक निर्गमित पुस्तक पर तीन रुपये प्रतिदिन के हिसाब से विलम्ब शुल्क देना होगा।
- ★ पुस्तकालय कार्ड गुम हो जाने पर 100/- रूपये जमा करवाने पर पुस्तकालय कार्ड की दोहरी प्रति बनवाई जा सकती है।
- ★ पुस्तकालय की पत्र-पत्रिकाओं तथा पुस्तकों पर कुछ भी लिखना, निशान लगाना तथा पृष्ठ फाड़ना सख्त मना है।
- ★ पुस्तकालय में अनौपचारिक वार्तालाप पूर्णतया प्रतिबंधित है।
- ★ खुली पुस्तकालय व्यवस्था (ओपन शैल्फ सिस्टम) के अंतर्गत अलमारियों से निकाली गई पुस्तकों को देखने व पढ़ने के पश्चात् उन्हें अलमारियों में स्वयं न रख कर निकटतम मेज पर ही रहने दें।
- ★ पुस्तकालय का अधिकाधिक सदुपयोग करें।
- ★ पुस्तकालय में किसी प्रकार के खाद्य व पेय पदार्थ का सेवन वर्जित है।
- अपनी पुस्तक पढ़ने के लिए पुस्तकालय में नवनिर्मित अध्ययन कक्ष में ही बैठें। पुस्तकालय की पुस्तक लेने की आवश्यकता होने पर ही पुस्तकालय में प्रवेश करें।
- ★ पुस्तकालय में प्रवेश करते ही उपस्थिति रजिस्टर पर हस्ताक्षर अवश्य करें, इसी आधार पर Best Library User का पुरस्कार प्रदान किया जाएगा।

9. <u>महाविद्यालय छोड्ने का प्रावधान</u>

★ विषम सत्र के आरम्भ में महाविद्यालय छोड़ कर जाने वाले विद्यार्थियों के लिए रजिस्टर से नाम कटवाना जरूरी है। ऐसा न करने पर उन्हें पूरी फीस देनी पड़ेगी। महाविद्यालय छोड़ने पर जमा कराए गए मूल प्रमाणपत्र यथाशीघ्र, किन्तु अधिक से अधिक छह मास में वापिस ले लिए जाने चाहिएं। इस समय के बाद महाविद्यालय उत्तरदायी नहीं होगा। ★ सत्र के बीच महाविद्यालय छोड़ने पर सिक्यूरिटी के अतिरिक्त कोई भी राशि वापिस नहीं की जाएगी।

10. प्रतिभूति (सिक्यूरिटी) की वापसी

- ★ पिछले सत्र की प्रतिभूति मार्च मास की 15 से 30 तारीख तक वापिस ली जा सकती है। ध्यान रहे, इनमें से किसी भी तारीख को सार्वजनिक अवकाश होने पर महाविद्यालय का कार्यालय बन्द रहेगा। दिनांक 30 मार्च तक प्रतिभूति वापिस न लिए जाने पर वह जब्त कर ली जाएगी।
- ★ प्रतिभूति की वापिसी के लिए विद्यार्थी को स्वयं प्रत्यक्ष रूप से महाविद्यालय के कार्यालय में उपस्थित होना पड़ेगा। किसी प्रकार के 'अधिकार–पत्र' से नियुक्त किसी प्रतिनिधि को प्रतिभूति की राशि का भुगतान नहीं किया जाएगा और न ही इसकी अदायगी मनीआर्डर/बैंक ड्राफ्ट इत्यादि के माध्यम से की जाएगी।

11. <u>सूचना पट (नोटिस बोर्ड)</u>

★ प्रतिदिन सूचना-पट अवश्य पढ़िए। आपकी जानकारी के लिए महाविद्यालय की विभिन्न गतिविधियों, योजनाओं, समारोहों और समाचारों की सूचनाएं, सूचना-पट पर लगा दी जाती हैं। सूचनाएं न पढ़ने की स्थिति में आप महत्वपूर्ण स्वर्णिम अवसरों का लाभ उठाने से वंचित रह सकते हैं। सूचना-पट न पढ़ने के कारण, सूचना न मिलने के आधार पर विद्यार्थी को होने वाली हानि व परेशानी हेतु महाविद्यालय प्रशासन उत्तरदायी नहीं होगा।

12. <u>पाठ्य व लेखन सामग्री</u>

★ कापी, पेन तथा प्राध्यापकों द्वारा अनुमोदित व निर्धारित पाठ्य पुस्तकें कक्षा में लाना आवश्यक है। इन के बिना कक्षा-कक्ष में जाने पर विद्यार्थियों के विरुद्ध अनुशासनात्मक कार्यवाही हो सकती है।

13. <u>दूरभाष का उपयोग</u>

★ कक्षाओं में चल-दूरभाष (मोबाइल फोन) का प्रयोग करना पूर्णतया वर्जित है। कक्षा में बिना शिक्षक की अनुमति के मोबाइल फोन इस्तेमाल करने पर 500/- रूपये का जुर्माना होगा। नितांत आवश्यक होने पर कार्यालय में नकद भुगतान कर सार्वजनिक दूरभाष सेवा का उपयोग कर सकते हैं।

14. <u>छात्रवृत्तियाँ</u>
